## Finishing Directions for Bowl Lid

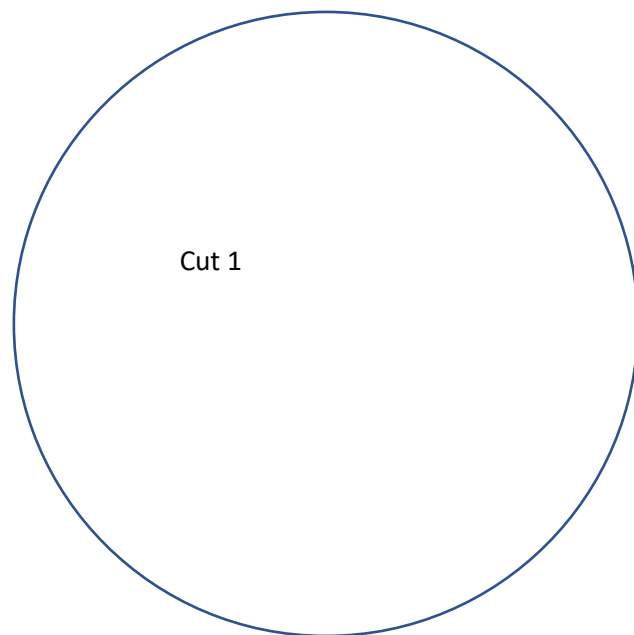
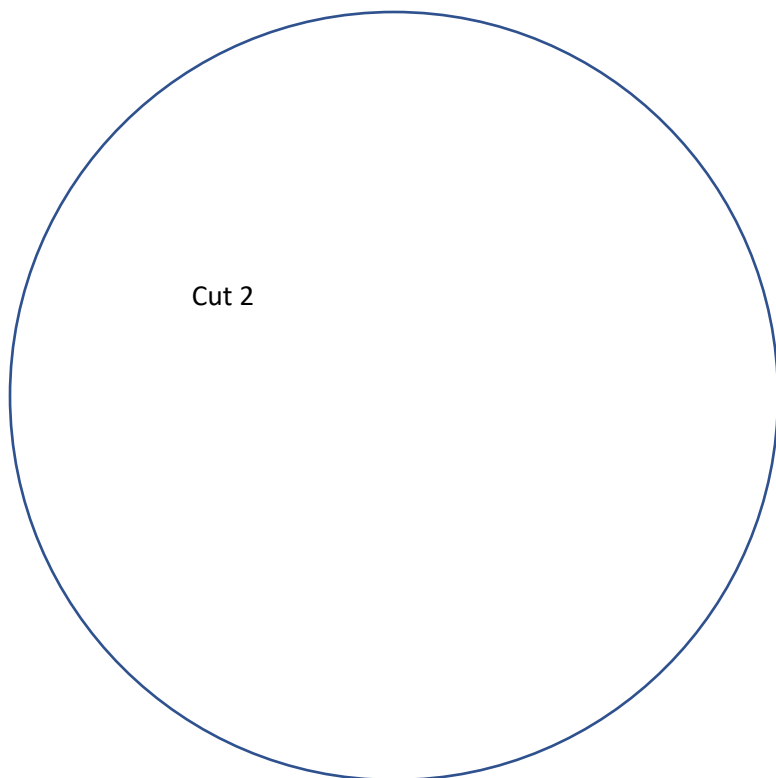
(These directions are based on designs finishing approximately 3 inches in diameter.)

1. Using large template, cut two circles from mat board.
2. Add batting to top of one large circle and lace stitching. (If your design allows, you may want to choose your favorite shank button to use for “handle.” With a large needle, thread floss through shank and take thread through the center of stitching, tie to back.)
3. Lace finishing fabric only on second large circle.
4. Sew two pieces together, add trim.
5. Using small template, cut one circle from mat board.
6. Add at least two layers of batting to “back” of small circle. This will become the underside.
7. Cut finishing fabric at least 1” larger than the small mat board circle. Lace, being sure there is enough batting for small circle to set ¼” away from large circle. This forms the completed lid. Center and glue the smaller covered circle to the backside of the large circle.

\*\*note: these directions and templates may need to be adjusted based on the size of the design you stitch and your HEARTWARE bowl. Each bowl is slightly different. For example, the smaller circle template is the approximate size needed. It should fit inside the top diameter of your bowl. If the circle is too large, just trim it until it fits inside the bowl top. It is the smaller circle that “anchors” your lid inside the bowl.
